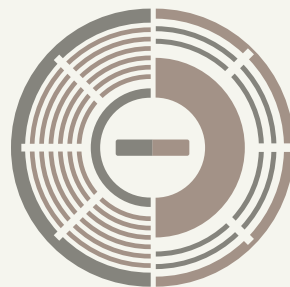

And I brought esparto from Cartagena. Our ships need your ropes, and we've missed your wine at our gatherings.



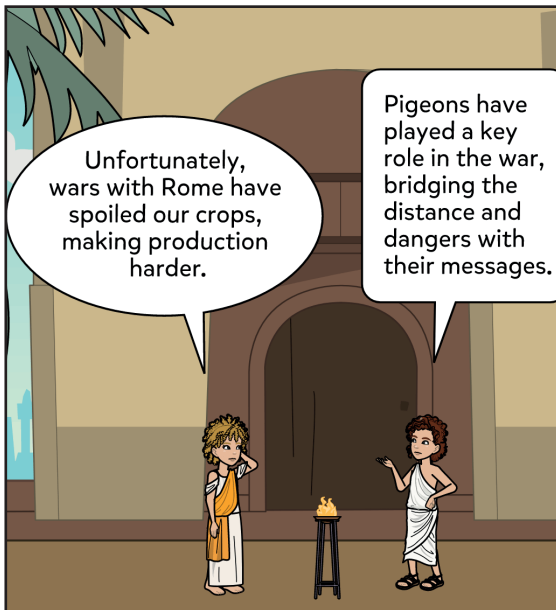
Getting here was tough. Wars and Roman rule have made our paths difficult.

Let's keep that vision. For now, let's enjoy our meeting and share our stories, imagining what Europe could become one day.



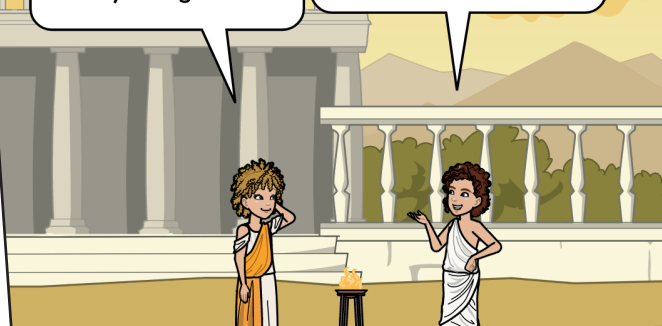
In Thessaloniki,

sails very slowly!

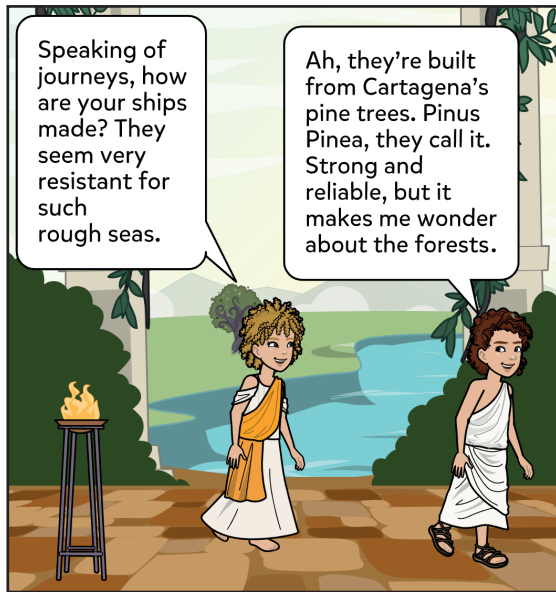


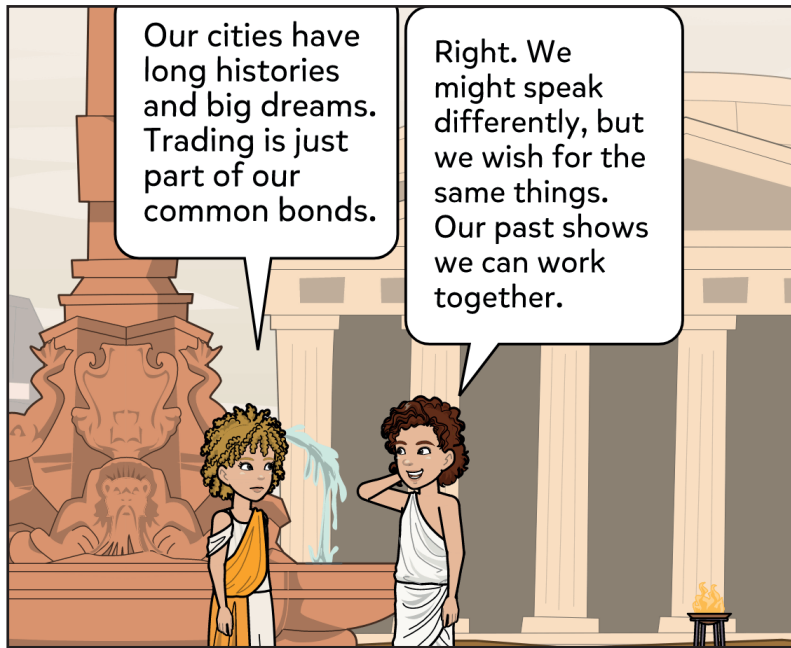

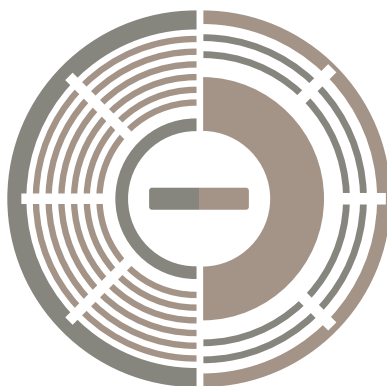
